

Abstract Submission for the Poster Presentation

We are inviting all colleagues who are interested to actively participate in the Congress to submit their abstracts for the poster presentation. Email for the formatted abstract submission: ups-spa@ups-spa.org

Deadline for the abstract submission – **15 May 2016**.

The decision about the abstract acceptance and instructions for the poster preparation will be announced after **25 June 2016**.

All accepted abstracts will be published in *Psychiatry Today*, the official journal of the Serbian Psychiatric Association.

General Instruction

Abstract can be written in Serbian or English language (Microsoft Word Document, Times New Roman font, 12pt, line spacing 1, use capital letters only at the beginning of the sentence or in the abbreviation; do not use the abbreviations in the title; all abbreviations in abstract must be explained when first introduced; do not use commercial drug names).

Abstract should not exceed 300 words, excluding title, authors and affiliations.

Tables, graphs and photos should not be included in the abstract.

Authors

Authors should be named below the title, in the following manner: family name, given name. The name of the presenting author should be underlined.

Affiliation

Affiliations should be stated below the names of authors and coauthors, in the following manner: institution, city, state. In the same order, separated by semicolon (;), state the affiliations of all authors in superscript with Arabic numbers, if the authors have different affiliations.

The address, telephone number and e-mail address of the presenting author or leading author should be stated after the abstract.

Structure of the abstract

Text should be divided into the sections (Introduction, Method, Results, and Discussion).

Abstract should include major findings from the presented study, as well as 3-6 key words. Use Medical Subject Headings – MeSH (<http://gateway.nlm.nih.gov>) to choose the key words.

Topic – research area

At the end of the abstract, state the number of chosen topic from the 12 topics below (topic number ...):

1. Organic mental disorders
2. Substance abuse
3. Psychotic disorders
4. Affective disorders
5. Anxiety and stress related disorders
6. Comorbidity of mental and somatic disorders
7. Personality disorders
8. Childhood and adolescence related disorders
9. Psychotherapy
10. Pharmacotherapy
11. Epidemiology of mental disorders
12. Miscellaneous
